The Victorian Code of Conduct for Community Sportoutlines behaviours that are expected of every personinvolved in community sport and active recreation, aswell as identifying the types of behaviours that will notbe tolerated.



## The Code:

Every person: spectator, player, club member, official,participant, administrator, coach, parent or member of thecommunity involved with the sport, should work to ensure:

- inclusion of every person regardless of their age, gender or sexual orientation
- inclusion of every person regardless of their race, culture or religion
- opportunities for people of all abilities to participate in the sport and develop to their full potential
- respect is shown towards others, the club and the broader community
- a safe and inclusive environment for all
- elimination of violent and abusive behaviour, protection from sexual harassment or intimidation.

This Code applies to community sport, training and clubsanctioned activities.
