The L.B.Davern Reserve committee is proud to announce that after a lot of work we have been successful in receiving a state government grant of \$250,000, with the Mitchell shire towards the Redevelopment of the top Netball/Tennis court. This redevelopment will include the total replacement of the court with lights. This project is to commence after Melbourne Cup day, so please be aware that area will be fenced off for contractors. **The Committee of management apologies for any inconvenience this may cause to our community.** The Court will be not available for Tennis for this period of time. Please contact the Tennis club for use on other courts.

New additions at the Reserve:

We have new signage at the Reserve to direct you in the right areas for the Facilities and car parking.

New rails at the Footy Scoreboard for assistance for the community who have difficulties getting up steps.

Road way to Stadium has 10 kilometre signs and beware of children signs, please take notice and care when driving up to Stadium and Tennis Courts.

Public Toilet Project:

The Reserve committee is working on providing a community public toilet for the community over at the horse ménage area of the Reserve to service the 2x horse riding club and dog club and other user groups and the community, just waiting on approval and permits from Council. **We may need community help to complete the project.** We are still waiting on confirmation in proceeding with the project.

To all user groups and the Community, bins are provided at the Reserve for the disposal of rubbish. Please make sure your areas are free of rubbish and place unwanted rubbish in the bins provided.
