THE 50 METRE RULE

Currently there is no charge for those residents who require 50 metres or less gas pipe from their property boundary to the meter box on their house.

Residents who require more than 50 metres must pay the total cost from the property boundary to the meter box on the house.

A.P.A. has been challenged re the inequality of this rule, apparently currently set in the contract and when contacted by the Wandong - Heathcote Junction Community Group, Michael Llewelyn, State Marketing Representative (Vic) advised that A.P.A. will see if anything can be done to rectify this.


WANDONG HEATHCOTE JUNCTION NATURAL GAS PROJECT - MARCH 2017

On Tuesday 28th February Australian Gas Networks held a public meeting at the Magpie and Stump Hotel, Wandong to update residents of Wandong - Heathcote Junction on the natural gas project. About 50 to 60 residents attended and heard that to date 87 applications had been received for connection to the net-work and three of these were already connected the previous week.

It was also good news for residents in the Mt View estate, North Mountain Road extension, Caledonia Court and for businesses on the western side of the railway line. AGN now have approval to extend the network by another 4 kilometres to these areas.

NATURAL GAS—TWO KILOMETRES TO GO - SEPTEMBER 2016

During the month of August Zinfra crews continued the works required to bring natural gas to Wandong-Heathcote Junction. Approximately 83% of the gas mains have now been laid (9,800m), leaving just two kilometres to go. The City Gate works in Junction Road are approximately 90% complete with a possible completion date of mid-October 2016.

Planning has now begun for the next stage of the project, which involves laying the services from the gas main to the individual residential and commercial properties, in preparation for gas meter installation.

Property owners who have made an application for gas will be contacted by a Zinfra representative to make an appointment to visit the property. The purpose of the visit is to determine the best location for the gas meter.


NATURAL GAS PROJECT PROGRESSING WELL - AUGUST 2016

Work required to bring natural gas to Wandong-Heathcote Junction is progressing well. At the end of July, Zinfra had finished laying nearly eight kilometres of reticulation mains throughout town. Of the three stages of work, the first stage is complete, the second stage is nearing completion and Stage 3 is well underway.

Additionally, gas supply pipework is being installed at the local gas city gate. A "city gate" has an important role in the natural gas distribution network, as it is the point where gas leaves the long distance transportation system for the lower pressure systems of local distribution companies, who then deliver the gas directly to your home or business.

The Zinfra crew has made good progress on the work required to bring natural gas to Wandong - Heathcote Junction. The team has been digging and drilling in Heathcote Junction streets and has now completed stage one of the reticulation works required as part of this three stage project. Works have also continued into stage two, and part of stage three is also complete. To date the crew has laid approximately 5,800 metres of reticula-tion mains which is 50% of the current requirements of the project. NATURAL GAS IN WANDONG - HEATHCOTE JUNCTION BECOMING A REALITY - June 2016

For the past month a crew of eight from contracting company Zinfra has been digging and drilling in Heathcote Junction streets installing Stage 1 of three stages to bring natural gas to Wandong - Heathcote Junction. Zinfra is delivering the works for APA Group, on behalf of Australian Gas Networks, owners of the gas network. Pictured is the team working in Range Avenue. Horizontal directional drilling is used to bore holes to connect pits dug at around 100-metre intervals, then 100 metres of gas piping is pulled back through the drilled holes. This method leaves the street largely unscathed. Weather permitting Zinfra hopes to have the works in Heathcote Junction streets (Eucalypt, Messmate, Range, View, Station, part of North Mountain, part of Rail) completed by mid- June.
